With those ten words, ask yourself why they are important and put them in descending order. You can do fewer words, but at most ten. It is about forcing a choice.

E.g., Is "Ambition" more critical than "Justice"?

Some will be easy some will be close. If these listed words do not fit, replace it with one that works better for you.

There is no right or wrong it is your list.

Look at your daily experience. How many of these values get expressed in work, with friends and family?

It is one of the many paths towards a good life.
